### ATTENDING A PET CREMATION AT DIGNITY

Clients can visit Dignity for Attended & Same Day services provided the below guidelines are followed.



#### MAKE AN APPOINTMENT BEFORE VISITING

Appointments for Attended & Same Day services are limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. If you are late for your appointment you will need to re-book. Your appointment will last no longer than 30 minutes.



#### UPON ARRIVAL RING BELL

Please do not arrive any earlier than 5 minutes before your scheduled appointment time. Signs will be posted outside directing which door to go to. Ring the bell and await a member of staff.



#### MASKS, HAND SANITISING & SIGNING IN

As the COVID-19 restrictions have now lifted we do not require clients to wear a face mask, however, we do encourage you to sanitise your hands upon arrival. Our team on the door will be wearing face coverings but it is at your discretion whether or not you decide to wear PPE. Please ensure you scan the QR code with your NHS Test & Trace app to sign in.



#### WE CAN NOW ACCEPT ITEMS WITH YOUR PET

You may place a few small items, e.g. toy, collar, photo, flowers, to be cremated with your pet. We cannot accept towels or duvets.



#### WE NEED ALL DETAILS IN ADVANCE

Prior to arriving at Dignity please make sure our team have all of your details, options and you have made payment in full and upfront during the initial call via credit or debit card.



#### ASHES COLLECTION

Unfortunately, we can't guarantee collection of ashes on the same day - it will be dependent on your appointment time so there may be a chance you have to collect ashes the following day.



#### OUR FACILITIES ARE OPEN

Our Farewell Rooms and toilets are now open inside. Our Gardens of Remembrance are also open on an appointment only basis.

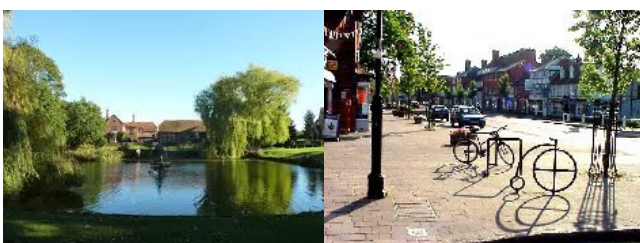

### **DIRECTIONS TO EATERIES**

#### **1) The Lord Derby Inn and Stocks Restaurant—RG29 1HD**

**Dist: 2.5 Miles (Pub and restaurant)** – Turn RIGHT onto A287 at the end of Odiham Road. Turn RIGHT at the roundabout (third exit). The Lord Derby can be found on the right hand side after about 150 yards.

#### **2) The Waterwitch—RG29 1AL**

**Dist: 3 Miles (Pub and restaurant)** – Turn LEFT onto A287 at the end of Odiham Road. Turn RIGHT at the roundabout into Odiham High Street. Take the second turning on the right (just before the vets, it is quite a sharp bend). The Waterwitch is on the left hand side towards the other end of the road.

#### **3) The Greenhouse—GU51 2XF**

**Dist: 6 Miles (Café & Restaurant)** – Turn LEFT out of Dignity and drive to end of Odiham Road. Turn right onto the A30. Turn RIGHT at the roundabout onto A323 Fleet Road. Continue over the railway bridge and turn LEFT onto Elvetham Road. Turn LEFT onto A3013 over railway bridge. Turn RIGHT at the small roundabout onto Cove road. Turn LEFT at the next roundabout then 1st LEFT into Farm Drive. Turn First RIGHT into Falkners Close. The Greenhouse is in the parade of shops.

#### **4) Fountain's Coffee Shop—RG29 1LP**

**Dist: 3 Miles (Café)** – Turn LEFT onto A287 at the end of Odiham Road. Turn RIGHT at the roundabout into Odiham High Street. The Café is located in the small shopping mall on the right hand side of Odiham High Street opposite Kings Chinese restaurant.

#### **5) The Bel and Dragon—RG29 1LP**

**Dist: 3 Miles (Café/Bistro)** – Turn LEFT onto A287 at the end of Odiham Road. Turn RIGHT at the roundabout into Odiham High Street. The Café is located next to The George hotel on the right hand side of the road.

#### **6) Café Theatre, Redfields Garden Centre—GU52 8UB**

**Dist: 6 Miles (Café/Bistro)** - Turn LEFT onto A287. Continue for 3 miles and turn LEFT into Redfields Lane (Church Crookham). Redfields is located on the right hand side after 1 mile.

#### **7) The Winchfield Inn—RG27 8BX**

**Dist: ¼ Mile (Pub/restaurant)**- Turn LEFT out of Dignity and take the second road on the right. The pub is located on the left hand side just after the train station

#### **8) The Barley Mow—RG27 8DE**

**Dist: 2 Miles (Pub/restaurant)**- Turn LEFT out of Dignity and take the second road on the right. Follow the road for about a mile and a half. The Barley Mow is on the left hand side.

#### **9) Mama Mia—RG27 8RT**

**Dist: 1 Mile (Restaurant)**- Turn LEFT out of Dignity and drive to end of Odiham Road. Turn right onto the A30. Mama Mia will be on your right hand side, after approximately 200m, opposite a car garage.

#### **10) The Phoenix Inn—RG27 8RT**

**Dist: 1 Mile (Pub/restaurant)** – Turn LEFT out of Dignity and drive to end of Odiham Road. Turn right onto the A30 and the Phoenix Inn will be on your right hand side.

#### **11) The Exchequer—GU51 5SU**

**Dist: 6 Miles (Pub/restaurant)**- Turn LEFT onto A287 at the end of Odiham Road. Go straight over at the roundabout (second exit) onto Farnham Road. Follow this road, passed the garage and petrol station, and turn left onto Crondall Road. Carry on for roughly a mile and a half and the Exchequer will be on your right hand side.

#### **12) Newlyn Farm Café—RG29 1HA**

**Dist: 2.5 Miles (Cafe)** – Turn RIGHT onto A287 at the end of Odiham Road. Turn RIGHT at the roundabout (third exit). Take first right towards Newlyn Farm.

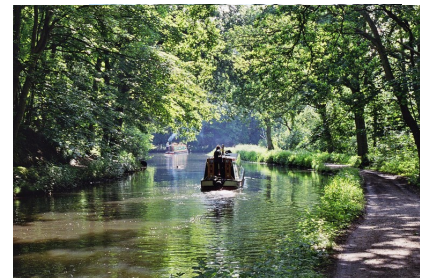
#### **13) Baristas—RG27 8NS**

**Dist: 2 Miles (Café)**- Turn left out of Dignity and at the end of the road turn right. Go straight over 2 mini roundabouts and this will take you to the high street. The café is on the left.





## LOCAL WALKS



*We are very near to the Basingstoke canal, which has some very picturesque walks along it. If you want you can combine a walk with something to eat at either The Exchequer (at Crookham Village, GU51 5SU) or The Waterwitch (at Odiham, RG29 1AL).*

### **1) Basingstoke Canal, ODIHAM, RG29 1AL**

**Dist: 3 Miles**

Turn LEFT onto A287 at the end of Odiham Road. Turn RIGHT at the roundabout into Odiham High Street. Go down the hill and turn RIGHT at the bottom of the slope into London Road, which takes you to the canal. You will go past the Waterwitch pub on the left hand side before reaching the canal car park.

### **2) Basingstoke Canal, CROOKHAM VILLAGE, GU51 5SU**

**Dist: 4 Miles**

Turn LEFT out of Dignity car park, take the second turning on the right (signposted to Winchfield). Carry on for approx. 3 miles until you go past the Queens Head pub and over a small bridge. Turn right when you reach a car garage (Village cars). The Exchequer pub is on the right hand side after about half a mile and the canal car park is just passed it on the right hand side.

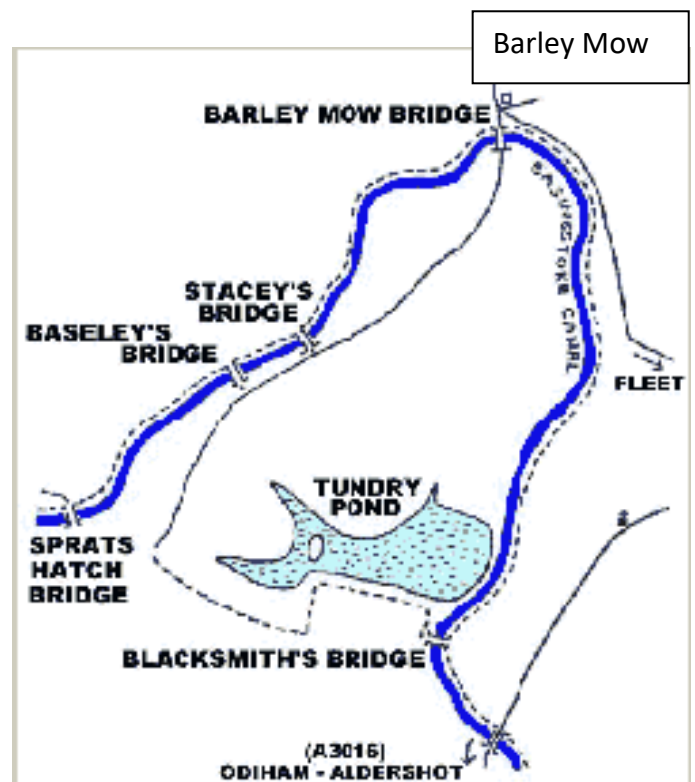
### **3) Basingstoke Canal, WINCHFIELD,**

**RG27 8DE**

**Dist: 2 Miles**

This is a walk that can be done by The Barley Mow pub, the entrance to the canal is located opposite the Barley Mow. It is approximately 4km long if you follow the dotted black line.

Turn LEFT out of Dignity and take the second road on the right. Follow the road for about a mile and a half. The Barley Mow is on the left hand side.

## **Festival Place, Basingstoke, RG21 7LJ**

*Festival Place is a fully covered, modern shopping centre in the centre of Basingstoke. It has a wide range of shops as well as several eateries.*

**Dist: 9 Miles** – Follow A30 or M3 to Basingstoke. Follow signs to Festival Place.

## **The Meadows, Camberley, GU47 0FD**

*The Meadows has a very large Marks & Spencer as well as a huge Tesco.*

**Dist: 7 Miles** – Turn RIGHT onto A30 towards Camberley. Follow signs to The Meadows

# GARDEN CENTRES

## **Redfields Garden Centre**

*A large garden centre with cafeteria.*

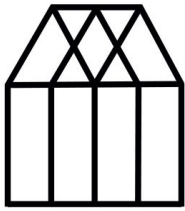
**Dist: 6 Miles** (with Licensed Restaurant) – Turn right out of Dignity Pet Crematorium and at the end of the road turn LEFT onto the A287. Continue for 3 miles and turn LEFT into Redfields Lane (Church Crookham). Redfields is located on the right hand side after 1 mile.

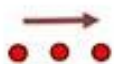
## Map of Dignity Pet Crematorium - Key

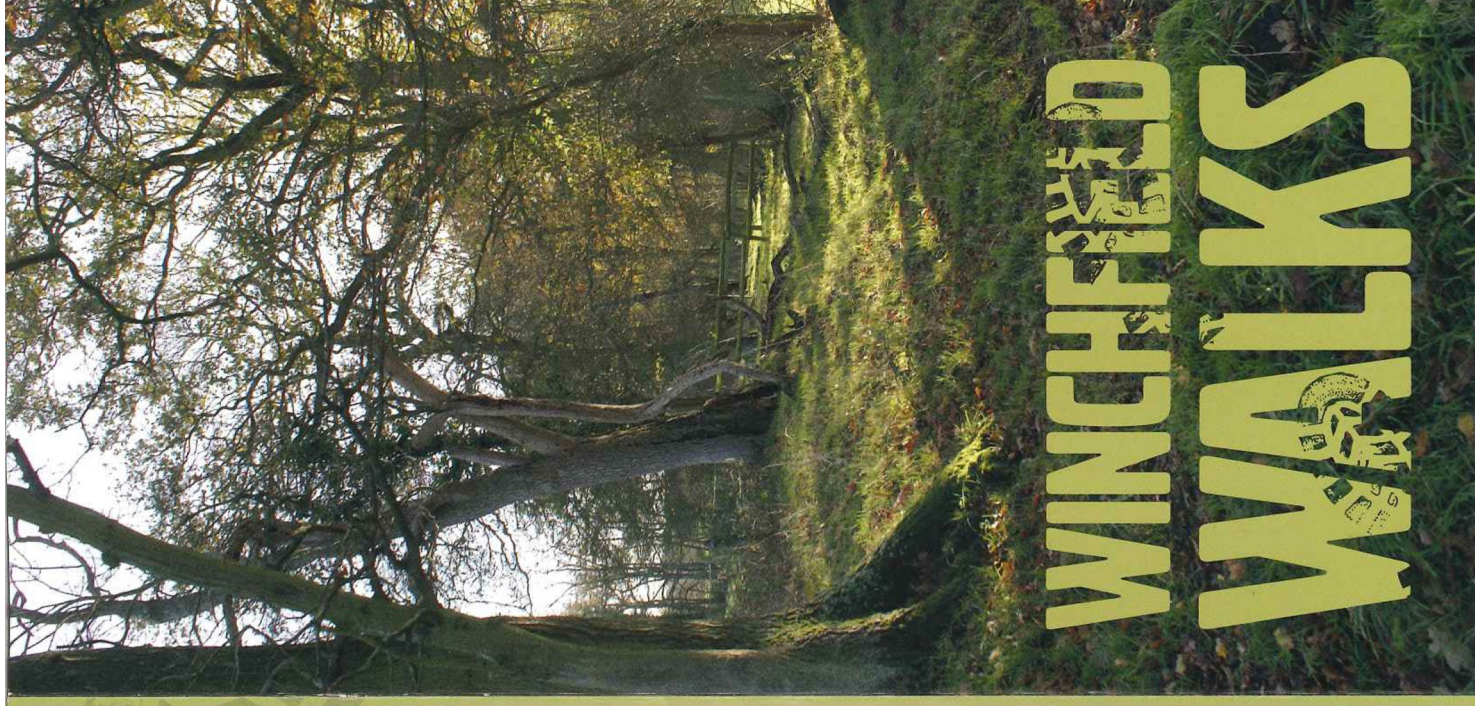
The canal has been designated a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) for its unique water chemistry, range of aquatic plants and variety of dragonflies and damselflies as well as a broad selection of wildlife.

You can also explore the fascinating history of Winchfield. Visit St Mary's Church. This beautiful Grade 1 listed church has played its part in Winchfield life for over 850 years and is the oldest listed building in the whole of Hart District. Find and explore the World War Two Pillboxes; these were built as an important line of defence in the event of an invasion.

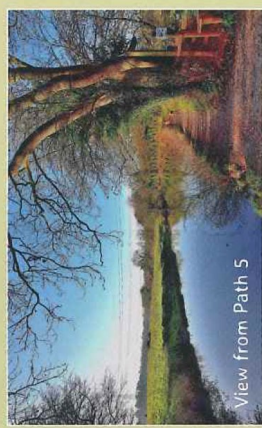

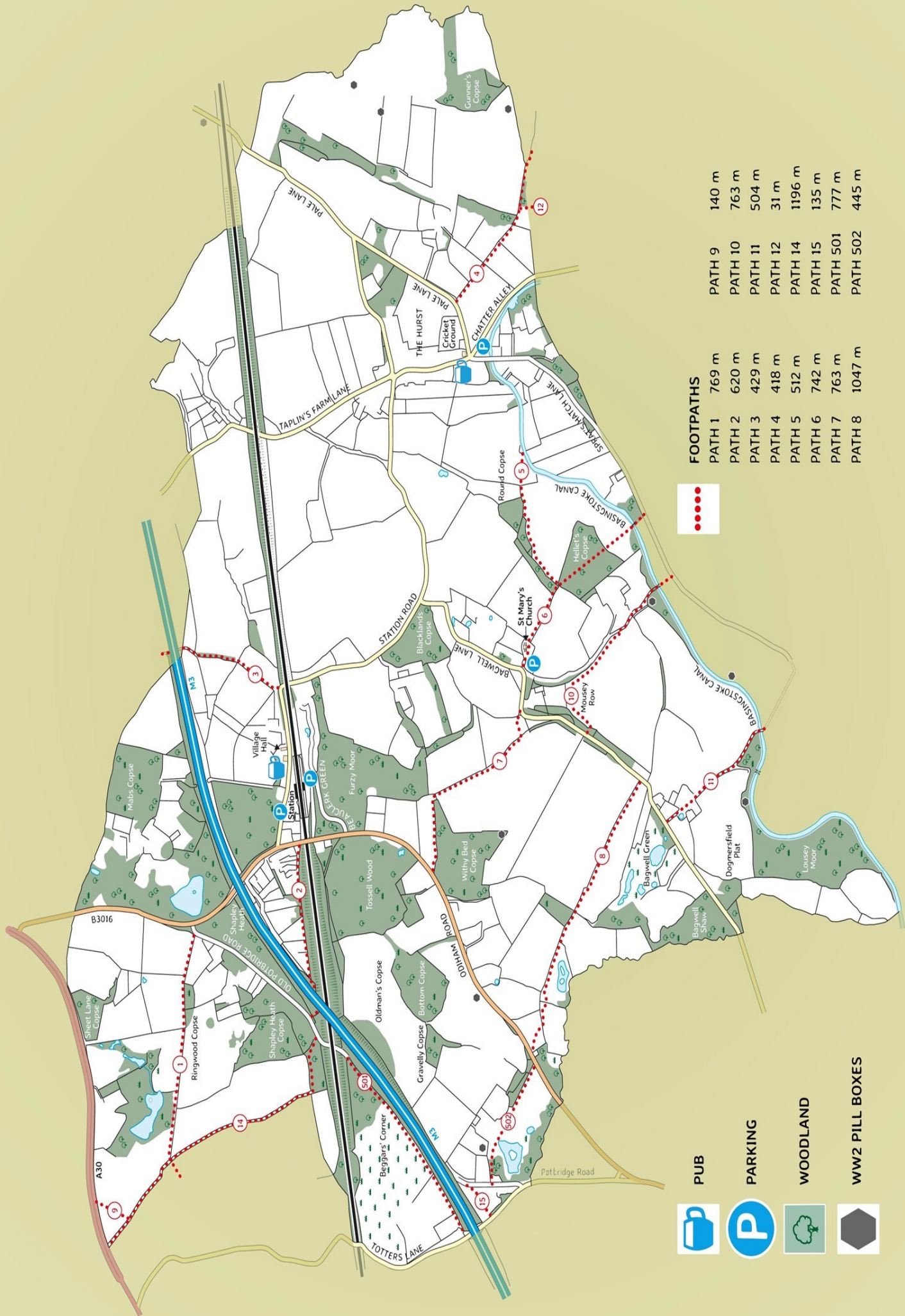
